

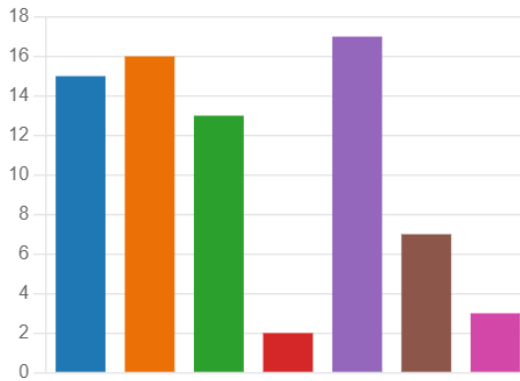
## Parent Survey Analysis

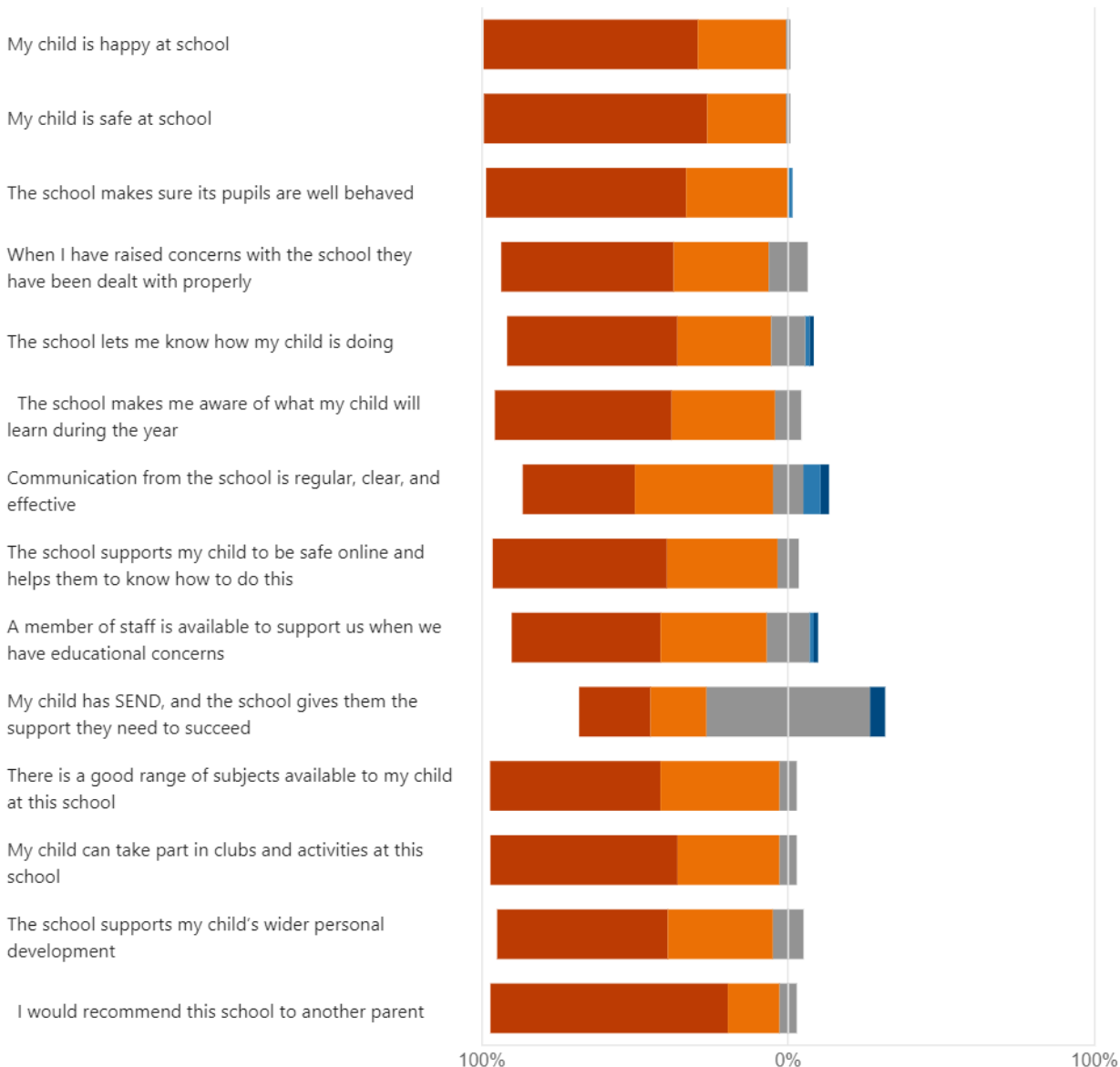

#### Overview:

- Parents strongly agree that their children felt safe and happy in school.
- From events and on a daily basis parents strongly agree that the children are well behaved in school.
- Overall, parents are happy that concerns are dealt with in a timely manner and properly.
- Improvement with communication this year has been a big success, with SLT making dates readily available in advance for parents.
- School offers a broad and balanced curriculum which is shared with parents at the start of each term via parent curriculum meetings.
- Parents agree that there are a good variety of clubs available and this is endorsed by our clubs being full.
- It is lovely to see that parents agree that the school supports their children's wider personal development and many have engaged with the myHappyMind scheme that we have brought into the school.
- We are extremely happy that the vast majority of parent would recommend our school to others.

#### Actions:

- Ensure that all new members of staff know how to deal with incidences to ensure that a consistent approach is continued throughout the school.
- Inform parents about how their children are doing e.g. parents evenings, reports, class email available for all.
- Communication platform to change (Arbor).
- Ensure there is an SEN option on survey of not applicable as many parent requested this option.
- Continue to offer a range of clubs with new clubs being considered e.g. art, languages

#### Next steps:

- Ensure all parents can access and are signed up to Arbor – access detail have been sent out.
- Online safety was taught as the first unit, but is continuously referred to throughout the year. This works in tandem with our whole school online charter.
- Modify survey following parents feedback and comments (SEN).
